New West End Middle School Update from principal, Kim Marr and vice principal, Angela Savory (other VP, France Samure-Mullins was absent):

- They visit the school every 2 weeks.
- 3rd floor is complete and working their way to the first floor.
- Basic furniture has been ordered.
- Staffing starts in the next few days.
- Approximately 750 students to start.
- Naming of the school is being done by an Indigenous committee. Name has been approved by the DEC and is awaiting approval from the Minister of Education.
- Planning for orientation as soon as it is possible.
- Feeder schools; Evergreen Park, Hillcrest, Edith Cavell
- The field that is next to the school is not regulation size, but at the back of BMHS they just turfed and fenced in a field that will be shared by both schools.

Principals Summary:

- Impact has started again and has 46 groups.
- Day of caring is June 14
- School wide spelling bee was had, lots of participants.
- Successful math competitions: three students have been invited to camps in the USA,
 UNB math competition is May 10

Provincial assessments:

- Grade 6: April 23/24 English literacy and scientific literacy
- o Grade 7: April 30/May 1 Math and English Literacy
- Grade 8: May 7 Scientific literacy

Oral proficiency interviews:

- o All grade 6-8 French immersion students have completed.
- o Random sampling from year 1, 2, 3 in English prime
- o Expectation to have oral proficiency continuum document by fall

Safety:

- Security concern in grade 7: login passwords. Passwords have been reset
- Teaberry situation is improving, lots of police presence

- We learn things that make me proud of my race/culture/ethnicity/heritage (52% of students)

PSSC Collaboration (HTHS and NFS)

- Other PSSC's are asking for support of a letter to be sent to the DEC and superintendent to lobby the government
- Safety issues:
 - Over 70 negative encounters with the unhoused population
 - Vandalism
 - Threats of violence and uttering threats
 - Removing feces and drug paraphernalia off school grounds
 - Finding unconscious people on school grounds
 - o There is a shelter on Mark Street that could be contributing to this
 - HTHS will present at next DEC meeting to hire security at the school. This has been a successful strategy used by other businesses in the area
